
32 PAGE PICTURE BOOK LAYOUT EXAMPLE — VERSION A, 14 SPREADS PLUS ONE PAGE




This is only one way to do the layout within 32 pages. You have 14 spreads plus one page (29pages). Story starts on p4-5 spreads and aends on p32. P4 can have dedication then story woul;d start on p5 and end on p32.

If you want to add back matter, it will take up the last 2-3 pages at least.

Yellow pages show the middle of the story.



32 PAGE PICTURE BOOK LAYOUT EXAMPLE — VERSION B, 15 SPREADS



This is only one way to do the layout within 32 pages.

You have 15 spreads, story starts on p2-3 and ends on p30-31. Copyright goes on the last page.

If you want to add some back matter, it will take up the last 2-3 pages at least leaving you one or two less spreads.

Yellow pages show the middle of the story.
