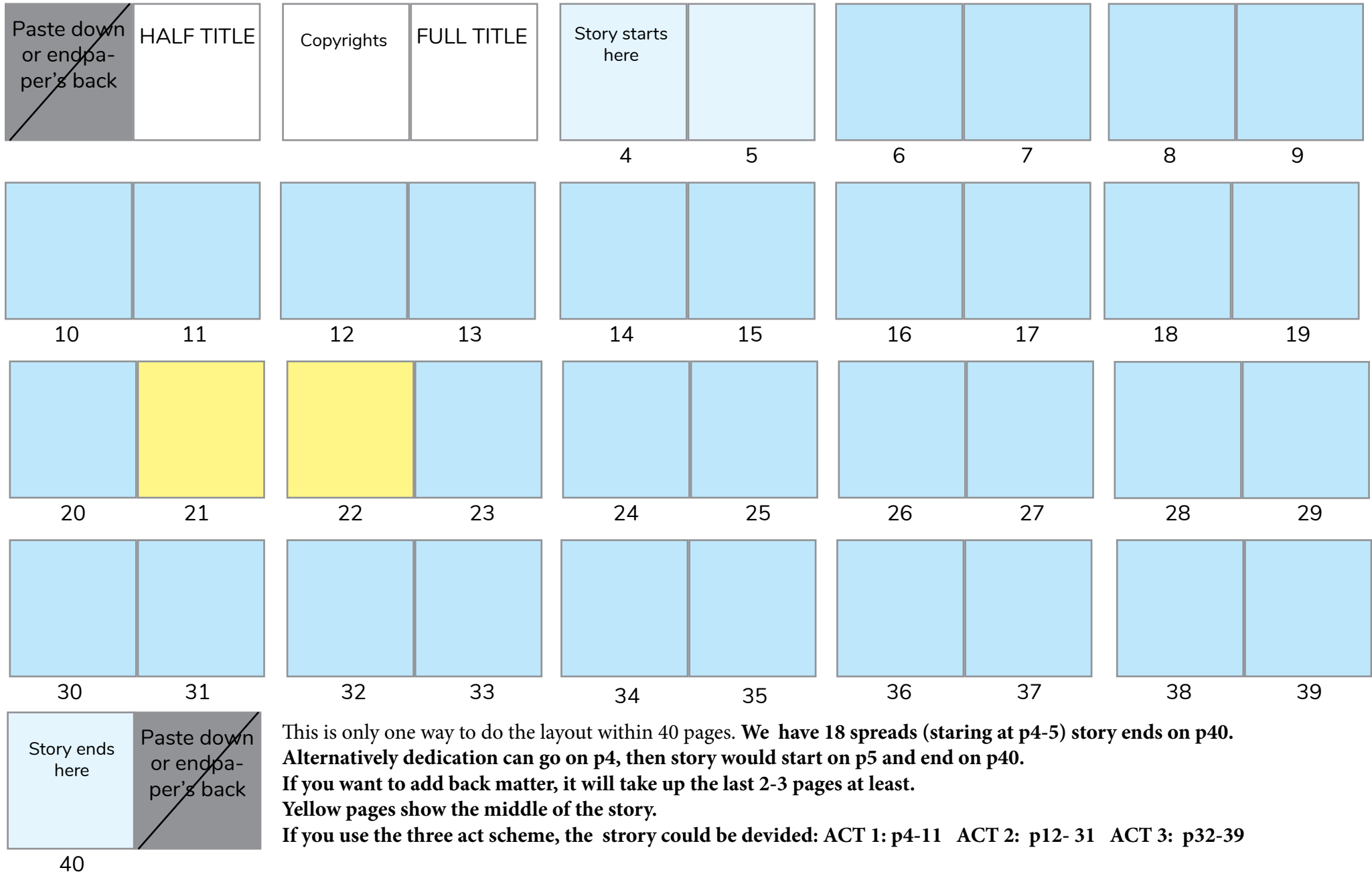
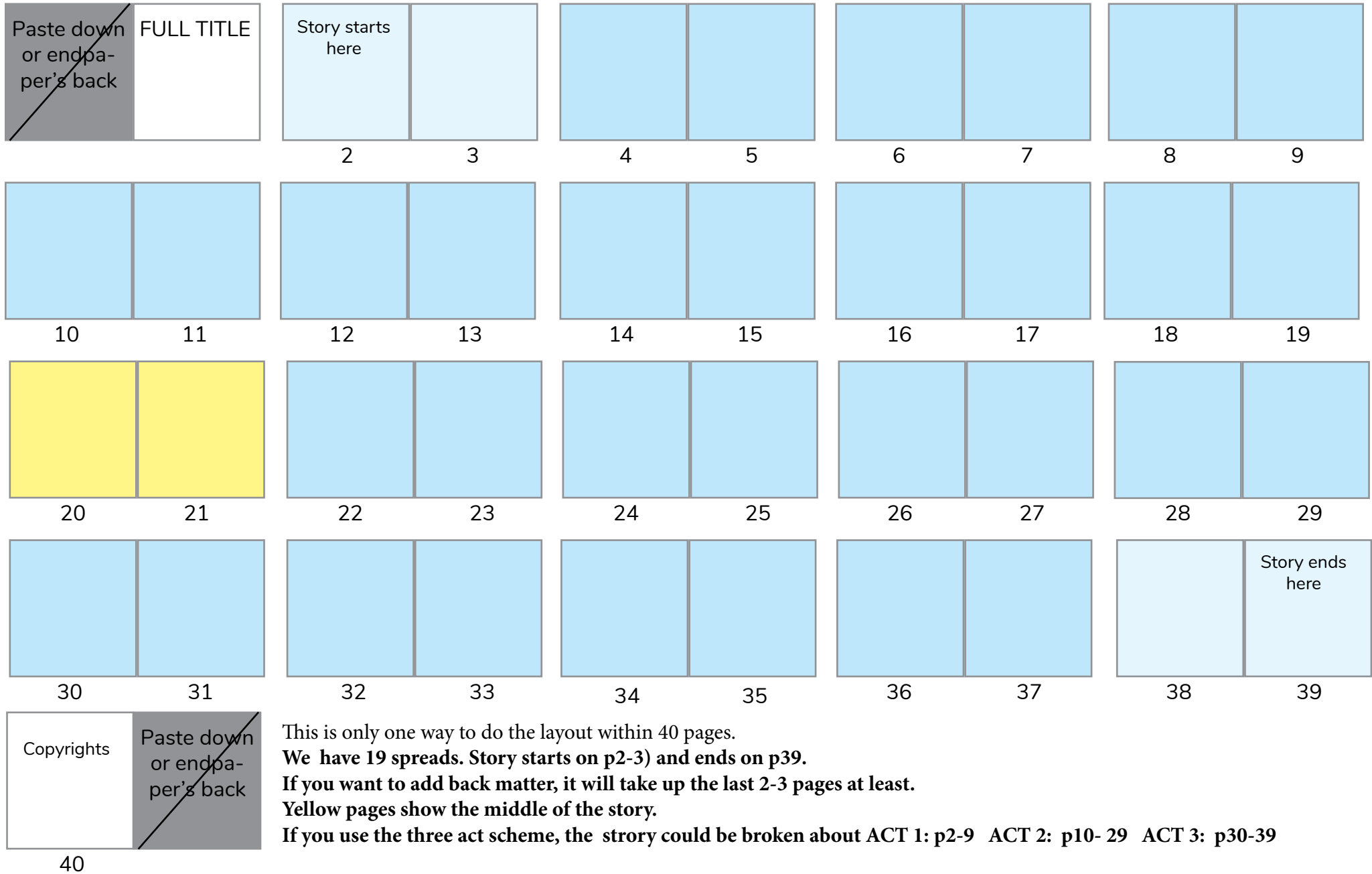


40 PAGE PICTURE BOOK LAYOUT EXAMPLE — VERSION A 18 SPREADS PLUS 1 PAGE



This is only one way to do the layout within 40 pages. **We have 18 spreads (starting at p4-5) story ends on p40. Alternatively dedication can go on p4, then story would start on p5 and end on p40. If you want to add back matter, it will take up the last 2-3 pages at least. Yellow pages show the middle of the story. If you use the three act scheme, the story could be divided: ACT 1: p4-11 ACT 2: p12- 31 ACT 3: p32-39**

40 PAGE PICTURE BOOK LAYOUT EXAMPLE — VERSION B 19 SPREADS



This is only one way to do the layout within 40 pages.
We have 19 spreads. Story starts on p2-3) and ends on p39.
If you want to add back matter, it will take up the last 2-3 pages at least.
Yellow pages show the middle of the story.
If you use the three act scheme, the story could be broken about ACT 1: p2-9 ACT 2: p10- 29 ACT 3: p30-39
