- scissors, school glue, color pencils, or markers

### OPTIONAL


- glitter, stickers or other small things to decorate your card


### INSTRUCTIONS

1. Print out the sheet. (Color Penguin.) (Panda does not need coloring.)
2. Cut out the character shape along the dashed lines.


3. Fold it half under her arms where the blue points are.




4. Fold both arms on the top until they are aligned with the edges.



5. Open back the arm foldings. Gently tuck and fold both arms between the two layers of body.



6. You should have a shape like below. Both arms (pink dots) are "inside".




7. Take your card, and align the cards folding with Penguin's (Panda's) "long arm folding".




8. Fold back the character to shape 6 and apply some glue over the back of the head. Align the foldings and stick it to the top part of the card. Wait 1 minute until it dries.






9. Apply glue on the lower part and stick it to the card too. Be careful not to put any glue on the arms. Wait a minute until it dries.




10. Decorate the front of your card.
